

Give Me a Brake!

One of the most important components of your Acura's braking system is the brake fluid. As you apply pressure to the brake pedal, the fluid transfers pressure to the brake caliper assemblies at each wheel. That's a simplified description of a complex process, which includes actions by the master cylinder, the ABS (anti-lock brake system) control unit, the calipers, and numerous sensors.

To ensure that these components continue to perform their intended function requires a fluid that does not compress and that can withstand very high temperatures without boiling.

Because brake fluid is hydroscopic, over time it can absorb moisture, lowering the fluid's boiling point and increasing the likelihood of corrosion in many critical components. That can compromise your safety and be expensive to repair.

Changing your brake fluid every three years and specifying Honda Heavy Duty DOT 3 brake fluid will help ensure that you get the maximum safety and service life from your braking system.
